

Raizer by Liftup

Imagine seeing someone, especially someone with mobility issues, fallen and laying on the floor. First thought, are they safe? Second thought, how are you going to get them back up?

The Raizer lifting chair could assist you in this situation. Raizer is a battery-operated chair that can help to move a person from floor level to a seated position within 30 seconds. An advantage of this device is that it only needs one person for assembly and operation. It comes packed in two bags which weigh in total 13 kg (seat 9 kg and legs and back rest 4 kg). It has a lifting capacity of 150 kg and takes 3 minutes to assemble. A battery-operated unit with buttons makes operation easy, and there is also a remote-control element available as an extra purchase.


A seat belt provides a sense of safety as the person is being lifted and continual eye contact can impart a sense of comfort. The person assisting uses minimal physical effort which helps to minimise the risk of injury to both the assister and person in need of assistance. This product could be helpful in nursing homes or assisted living settings. It is easy to clean and has an optional extra cover.
